Overall Purpose of Job:

Huddersfield Giants Community Trust based at The Zone in Huddersfield are commissioned to deliver The National Citizen Service (NCS) program. The NCS program offers 16 and 17-year-olds from different backgrounds the opportunity to build skills for future work and life. The scheme aims to bring young people from different backgrounds together to develop greater confidence, self-awareness and responsibility. It encourages personal and social development by working on skills like leadership, teamwork and communication.

Main Responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver high quality NCS provision and programs
- Oversee the delivery of all components of the program curriculum, driving a highquality standard of delivery throughout
- Manage and coordinate a staffing team
- Oversee the NCS recruitment strategy in line with contractual expectations
- Build and maintain effective working relationships across Huddersfield, to enhance program delivery and social action partnerships.
- To maintain key stake holder relationships, vital to the success and flagship status of the NCS program in Huddersfield
- To work alongside the senior management team in budget management in accordance to NCS contract and finances
- Work closely with the EFL Trust Performance Management Partner to ensure all contractual compliance is delivered to the highest possible standard.
- Lead on safeguarding protocols and compliance in accordance to local and nation policy and procedures
- Recruit staff to deliver the program in line with Huddersfield Giants Community Trust safer recruitment strategy
- Work with families, participants, and external services to ensure all participants needs have been identified and their experience on NCS is safe, inclusive and rewarding.
- To maintain accurate records which measure the impact of delivery, including written reports and case studies ensuring all required data is collated for the monitoring and evaluation of the project



- Management of virtual, local, and residential delivery of the program, including social action and the changemakers program.
- To attend related networks, meetings and NCS events, supporting partnership and sharing good practice
- To ensure equality, diversity and inclusion expectations are met in conjunction with HGCT policy and procedures
- To manage the logistics of all NCS program delivery
- To work along NCSTRUST and EFLT to effectively promote, and market the NCS program throughout Huddersfield.
